NOTICE TO BIDDERS
CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION

Macungie Borough Council is accepting sealed bids for Curbside Leaf Collection, as described in the Bidding Documents, until 1:00 p.m. Friday, March 22, 2019, at Macungie Borough Hall, 21 Locust Street, Macungie, PA at which time the bids will be opened and read aloud.

Bid packets may be obtained at Macungie Borough Hall, 21 Locust Street, Macungie, PA, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Submitted bids shall be clearly marked "Curbside Leaf Collection" and include the bidder's name. All Bids must be submitted using the Bid Proposal Form included in the Bidding Documents and shall be accompanied by a properly executed Non-Collusion Affidavit, the requisite bonds and all other required documents specified in the Bidding Documents. Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Certified Check, or Money Order in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid submitted for consideration. Bids will not be accepted after the 11:00 a.m. deadline set forth above. All Bids must be valid and remain subject to acceptance for a period of not less than sixty (60) days from the opening of the Bids. The successful bidder shall, within 20 days after notification of award, enter into a written contract with the Borough, and deliver the requisite bonds guaranteeing performance of the contract in the amount of 100% of the total contract price as set forth in the Bidding Documents.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid. The successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

The Borough expressly reserves the right to reject or accept any or all bids and may re-advertise if the best interests of the Borough are to be hereby promoted. The Borough may waive technical defects if, in its judgment, the best interests of the Borough shall so require. No bid may be considered from any person, firm or corporation who has defaulted in the performance of any contract or agreement previously made with the Borough or conclusively shown to have failed to perform satisfactorily such contract or agreement with the Borough.
