The Borough of Emmaus operates a lawn and garden waste composting facility at Klines Lane and Minor Streets for use by individuals. Since 2014, Emmaus Borough charges for the use of the compost site.

There is a charge of \$20 for a permit for the Macungie residents.

(Loading from 3:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.)

8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (No Loading)

CLOSED the following days: Friday, April 15th, Monday, May 30th, Monday, July 4th, Monday, September 5th, Friday, November 11th, and Friday November 25th

PLEASE PRESENT YOUR COMPOST PASS AND A PICTURE ID
THERE WILL BE NO ADMITTANCE WITHOUT PROPER IDENTIFICATION

The following items will be accepted in the condition as described:

Leaves/leafy stems/grass and grass clippings: Brought in reusable container(s) and emptied on the pile as indicated. Grass and Leaves may be mixed.

Woody branches up to 3" in diameter: Reduced to lengths not exceeding 6', placed in/on the pile as indicated.

Firewood logs from freshly cut trees: From 3" diameter up to 24" diameter. Cut in 20" lengths. All limbs and branches must be cut off.

Only organic yard waste is accepted. No lumber, root balls with dirt, garbage, dirt, building materials, etc., is allowed. This is not a dump. If you observe any violations, please obtain the offender's license plate number and report the incident to the Public Works Department at 610-965-9288 (after hours, please leave a message). Your report will remain anonymous. When wood chip mulch and/or compost is available, Public Works personnel will load trucks and trailers on Wednesdays after 3:00 p.m. and on Saturdays.

We request the cooperation of all participants and remind everyone plastic bags or any other foreign materials are not to be included with the yard waste. Failure to follow any of the above mentioned instructions or the instructions of the site attendant may result in the forfeiture of one's privileges.

Unscreened compost and wood chip is available for a loading fee of \$25 per scoop or partial scoop. Only pickups or small trailers will be loaded. Please call the Emmaus Public Works Department at 610-965-9288, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with any questions or for additional information. They will stop loading 45 minutes prior to closing so that equipment can be cleaned.

Screened compost is available to *Emmaus residents only*.

Please call the Macungie Borough office at 610-966-2503, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., with any questions or comments.
